ANNUAL RATEPAYERS' MEETING,

November 3, 1948.

The Annual Meeting of the Ratepayers of Rocanville R.M. No. 151 was held in the Community Hall on Wednesday, November 3, 1948, with 52 Ratepayers present. Mr. C.F. Chase was elected as Chairman of the meeting, and called the meeting to order at 1.15 M.S.T.

The minutes of the last Annual meeting were read and adapted on motion of W.E. McClelland and A. Calder.

At 2.00 P.M. (M.S.T.) or 3.00 P.M. (Local Time), the Secretary, as Returning Officer, declared the meeting open for nominations for the office of Reeve, and for Councillors for Div. 1, 2, 3, and 5, Councillor Kennedy's resignation having been tendered to take effect Dec. 31, 1948.

At 3.00 P.M. (M.S.T.) or 4.00 P.M. (Local Time), the Returning Officer declared nominations closed, and on the basis of nominations received:

Louis Gagnon was declared^{re}/elected by acclamation as Councillor for Div. 1, for the ensuing TWO years;

C.C. Hutchinson was re-elected as Councillor for Div. 3, for the ensuing TWO years;

A Poll was declared throughout the Municipality for the election of a Reeve for the ensuing ONE year, the nominees for that office being Alex. Calder and Jos. Goodman;

A Poll was also declared in Div. 2 and 5, for the election of Councillor, the nominees being:

In Div. 2: Chas. Dumville, A. Marlatt, and E. Thompson; In Div. 5: B. Kaplun and Geo. Williamson.

The Interim NINE months' Financial statement was given by the Secretary, discussed and adapted on motion of J. Heap and J. Goodman.

A report on Tax collections was given by the Secretary

Councillor Sutton reported on behalf of the Agricultural Committee and urged better attendance at the Committee meetings.

Considerable discussion was given to the matter of road improvement. The need to improve the standard of our main market roads was emphasised, and also the importance of keeping the ~~####~~ Big outfit on the job of roadwork in order that each Division would be sure of its turn with the outfit.

Short addresses were given by retiring Reeve C.F. Chase and by the nominees for Reeve, Alex. Calder and Jos. Goodman.
