Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151

Þ BYLAW TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES AND THE USE OF THE HIGHWAYS

Saskatchewan enacts as follows: The Council of the Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151 in the Province of

- In this bylaw, including this section:
- <u>a</u> "all terrain vehicle" and/or "ATV" means all terrain vehicle as defined in *The All* Terrain Vehicles Act;
- <u></u> road, parkway, driveway, square or place designed and intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles, but does not include any area, whether privately or publicly owned, that is primarily intended to be used for the "highway" means a highway as defined in The Highway Traffic Act and includes parking of vehicles and the necessary passageways on that area;
- C Vehicles Act; private land" means land other than public land as defined in *The All Terrain*
- 9 "public land" means Crown land or any land vested in the municipality, as defined in The Terrain Vehicles Act.
- Ĵ e untravelled portion" means that part of a highway not designed for vehicle travel "traveled portion" means that part of a highway designed for vehicle travel including the shoulder of the road;
- 9) including the ditch and the center median, if any; "vehicle" means a vehicle as defined in The Highway Traffic Act.
- the A person is authorized to operate an all terrain vehicle (may specify class of ATV) on traveled portion of any highway within the municipality.
- Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalty imposed by section 32 of The All Terrain Vehicles Act.
