1955 ... Annual Meeting ... R.M. No. 151

Oct. 24, 1955.

The Annual meeting of Rocanville R.M. No. 151 was held on Oct. 24, 1955 with a large number of ratepayers in attendance.

Mr. H.C. Watson was nominated to be chairman for the meeting, and on motion of Wm Karras and R. Wilson nominations closed and Mr. Watson assumed the chair.

The minutes of last meeting were read and adapted on motion of W.E. McClelland and A. Stewart

The proposed agenda for the meeting as outlined by the Secretary was adapted on motion of A. Gray and Geo. Williamson.

The Nine-months financial report was read and received on motion of W.E. McClelland and J.E. Dumville.

At the specified time the Returning-officer declared nominations were open for the space of ONE hour to receive nominations for Councillors for Div. 2, 4 and 6. At the end of the period, the Returning-officer announced that ALL THREE of the present Councillors were re-elected by acclamation for two years, viz.-

Div. 2.... J.A. Reavie;

Div. 4 ... H.W. Hooper;

Div. 6 ... C.W. Salonen;

Thereafter reports were given by Council members who were present. Reeve Calder reported on the Valley bridges problem, and gave a general outline of the work of the year;

The Councillors for Div. 2,3,4,5, & 6 gave a report on road-work problems and expenditures in the divisions; the Councillors for Div. 5 and 6 also referring to the difficulties re Valley bridges

The three re-elected Councillors (For Div. 2, 4, and 6) thanked the ratepayers for the expression of reassurance and asked for continued cooperation in future.

The matter of the Mun. Dr area in the Westbportion of the R.M., and the question of some other pre-paid medical scheme was considered and it was felt that this matter should receive more attention at an early date.

The question of Bangs' Disease and Vet. problems were also discussed. Mention was made of the difficulty in getting the vaccination and Bangs' testing done.

D. Sutton and Wm Karras moved that the Agric. Committee investigate the possibility of forming a Veterinary Services district to comprise 3 R.M.'s including R.M. No. 151. Motion carried.

There was considerable discussion re the work and problems of the Municipality.

The meeting adjourned at 5.00 P.M.
