

BYLAW NO. 2-2006

Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151


A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by the Municipal Act;
 - (b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by the Traffic Safety Act.
2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle;
 - (a) at a speed greater than 50 kilometers per hour on that portion of a public highway within the Hamlet of Ste. Marthe; and
 - (b) at a speed greater than 60 kilometers per hour on that portion of of public highway described as follows:
South of Section 28, Township 16, Range 31, West of the first meridian.
3. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed zone area.
4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
5. Bylaw No. 2-91, passed on March 15, 1991, being a bylaw to regulate the speed of motor vehicles, is hereby repealed.
