ANNUAL RATEPAYERS' MEETING,

NOVEMBER 5, 1947.

The Annual Ratepayers' meeting of Rocanville R.M. No. 151 was held in the Community Hall, on Wed., Nov. 5, 1947, at 1.00 P.M. (M.S.T.), with 34 ratepayers present.

On motion of J.F. Rushton and I.J. Rudhton, Reeve C.F. Chase was chosen as chairman of the meeting.

Reeve Chase opened the meeting with a few introductory remarks re the financial position of the Municipality.

On motion of J.B. Chase and W.E. McClelland the minutes of the last annual meeting were adapted as read.

At the specified time the Returning Officer called for nominations for Reeve and for Councillors for Divisions No. 2, 4, and 6. At 3.00 P.M. nominations were closed and on the basis of nominations received, the Returning Officer declared C.F. Chase re-elected as Reeve for the ensuing one year, and that Bernard Wislon was re-elected as Councillor for Division six, for the ensuing two years. He also declared that a Poll would be held on the following Wednesday in Division 2, and in Division 4; the nominees being:

For Councillor, Div. 2 .. Jos. Goodman; Geo. Kennedy;

For Councillor, Div. 4 .. Wm Duce; D.N. Sutton.

Reeve Chase addressed the meeting and gave an outline of plans and problems of road construction and repair in this Municipality. He pointed out that unusual weather conditions of last June and the delay in getting delivery of a Caterpillar tractor were two important factors which retarded roadwork plans, this year.

Councillors Gagnon, Goodman, Williamson, Wilson, and retiring Councillor Dunsmore all addressed the meeting briefly.

Short addresses were also given by nominees, W.E. Duce, D.N. Sutton and G.K. Kennedy.

There was general discussion re the need of better roads in this Municipality, and some suggestions were made re the advisability of having a motorpatrol or patrols for maintaining roads which ~~which~~ were up to standard or would be brought up to standard in the near future. Mention was made also of the value of having a small scraper to work in conjunction with the motor patrol if obtained.

H.C. Watson gave an outline of the aims and objects of the Agricultural Committee recently formed, and announced that an Agricultural school was to be held in Rocanville in November.
