PAYMENT OF INDEMNITY

Payment of indemnity owing for claims begins the last week of August, except where deferred payment has been requested. For claims received on crown leased land unpaid current hail taxes will be deducted from the indemnity owing. If arrears of hail taxes exist, a deduction will be made for the arrears plus the current hail taxes outstanding. Where deferred payment has been requested, a letter will be mailed to the claimant after October 15th indicating the amount of indemnity owing.

COLLECTION AND REMITTANCE OF HAIL TAXES

Hail taxes are to be shown on the tax notice and must be collected in the same manner and are subject to the same penalties as municipal taxes, and if unpaid when due, are recoverable in all respects as municipal taxes are recoverable pursuant to *The Municipalities Act*.

Discounts for prompt payment of current hail taxes are allowed as follows:

5% if paid before October 1

• 4% if paid on or after October 1 but before November 1

Now. • 2% if paid on or after November 1 but before December 1

Also before the mailing of tax notices in any year council may, by bylaw, provide for an additional discount for the prompt payment of current hail taxes of not more than 1% for each month before September in the year in which the rates are levied. *Municipal Hail Insurance Act Sec. 26*.

The Municipalities Act states that SMHI is a taxing authority and any payments made must first be applied to arrears and then to current taxes. As well, if a partial payment is made the payment must be apportioned amongst all taxing authorities.

If hail taxes are collected in any month, the total monthly collection is to be remitted to the Association by cheque along with the preprinted monthly statement on or before the tenth day of the following month. If no collections are made in any month, a "nil" monthly statement must be made.

The Municipal Hail Insurance Act provides authorization for municipalities to pay out hail levies to the Association even if all taxes are not collected. If this is done, the Administrator should transfer all uncollected hail taxes to the Municipal Tax section of the tax roll. Any penalties resulting therefrom are then the property of the municipality. Discounts allowed on settlement are subject to the same rates as mentioned above.

When the hail levy is paid in full, indicate on the monthly statement "paid in full". The Administrator is no longer required to forward monthly statements once the levy is paid out.

At the end of the year, each municipality will receive an Annual Statement. The Administrator will be required to complete and return the statement by January 10th.

BYLAW NO. 5 - 2008

Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PROPERTY TAX INCENTIVES DISCOUNT

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. **Due Date**

Property and other taxes imposed by the Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151, are deemed to be imposed on the first day of January in each year and shall be due on December 31.

- Discretionary Provision: Incentive Program Prompt Payment 2.
 - Discounts shall be allowed from the time the notice of the levy is sent until November 30, to encourage prompt payment of the current year's taxes on property.
 - b) Payments of current taxes received:
 - from the time the notice of the levy is sent until the end of September shall be eligible for a discount of 5.0000% of the amount paid:
 - during the month of October shall be eligible for a discount of ii) 4.0000% of the amount paid; and
 - during the month of November shall be eligible for a discount of iii) 2.0000% of the amount paid.
- Discretionary Provision: Incentive Program Prepayments 3.
 - From January 1 until August 31 discounts shall be allowed with respect a) to the prepayment of the current year's taxes on property; b)
 - The rate of discount relative to prepayment of taxes
 - Constant discount shall be 5.0000%.
- Repeal Previous Incentive Tax Discount 4. Bylaw # 7-2001 is hereby repealed.

BYLAW NO. 4 - 2008

Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY MEASURES ORGANIZATION

WHEREAS the council of the Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151 is responsible for the direction and control of its emergency response and is required under the Emergency Planning Act 1989, to appoint a Emergency Planning Committee and to Establish and maintain an Emergency Measures Organization; and

WHEREAS it is desirable in the public interest, and in the interest of public safety, that such a committee be appointed and such an agency be established and maintained to carry out Council's statutory powers and obligations under the said Emergency Planning Act:

NOW, THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROCANVILLE NO. 151 DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Emergency Measures Organization Bylaw.
- 2. In this Bylaw,
 - (a) "Act" means the Emergency Planning Act;
 - (b) "Council" means the Council of the Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151;
 - (c) "Disaster" means an event that has resulted or may result in serious harm to the safety, health or welfare of the people, or in a widespread damage to property;
 - (d) "Emergency Planning Committee" means the committee established under this Bylaw;
 - (e) "Emergency" means a present or imminent event that requires prompt co-ordination of action or special regulation of persons or property to protect the health, safety or welfare of the people or to limit damage to property;
 - (f) "Minister" means the Minister responsible for the Act;
 - (g) "Emergency Measures Organization: (EMO) means the agency established under this Bylaw; and
 - (h) "Municipal Emergency Plan" means the emergency plan prepared by the EMO Co-ordinate response to an emergency or disaster.
 - (i) "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151.
- There is herby established a Emergency Planning Committee to advise council on the development of emergency plans and programs.
- 4. There is hereby established and Emergency Measures Organization to act as the agent of Council to carry out its statutory powers and obligations under the Act. This does not include the power to declare, renew, or terminate a state of local emergency, nor the powers contained in Section 12 of this Bylaw.
- 5. Council shall:
 - by resolution appoint 3 (three) of its members to serve on the Emergency Planning Committee;
 - (b) provide for the payment of expenses of the members of the Emergency Planning Committee;
 - (c) by resolution, on the recommendation of the Committee, appoint a chairperson;
 - ensure that emergency plans and programs are prepared to address potential emergencies or disasters in the municipality;
 - (e) approve the Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151's emergency plans and programs;&
 - review the status of the Municipal Emergency Plan and related plans and programs at least once each year.
- 6. Council may:
 - by Bylaw borrow, levy, appropriate and expend, without the consent of the electors, all sums required for the operation of the Emergency Measures Organization; and
 - (b) enter into agreements with and make payments or grants, or both, to persons or organizations for

provision of services in the development or implementation of emergency plans or programs, including mutual aid plans and programs.

7. The Emergency Planning Committee shall:

- (a) review the Municipal Emergency Plan and related plans and programs on a regular basis;
- (b) advise Council, duly assembled, on the status of the Municipal Emergency Plan and related plans and programs at least once a year.
- 8. The Municipal EMO shall be comprised of one or more of the following:
 - (a) the EMO Coordinator
 - (b) the Deputy Coordinator
 - (c) the Manager, Administrator, Clerk or other administrative staff member(s) of the Municipality;
 - the Police Chief or designate or the N.C.O. in charge, Royal Canadian Mounted Police or designate;
 - (e) the Fire Chief or designate;
 - (f) the Public Information Officer or designate;
 - (g) the Public Works Foreman or designate;
 - (h) the Ambulance Service manager or designate;
 - (i) the Community Development Manager or designate;
 - (j) the Health Unit Manager or designate;
 - (k) the Hospital Director or designate;
 - (l) the Recreational Director or designate;
 - (m) the School Board Chairman;
 - (n) the Social Service manager;
 - representative(s) from adjacent communities which have entered into a mutual aid agreements;
 - (p) representative(s) from local business or business associations;
 - (q) representative(s) from the railway if applicable;
 - (r) anyone else who might serve a useful purpose in the preparation or implementation of the Municipal Emergency Plan.

9. The EMO Coordinator shall:

- (a) prepare and co-ordinate the Municipal Emergency Plan and related plans and programs for the municipality;
- (b) act as director of emergency operations, or ensure that someone is designated under the Municipal Emergency Plan to act, on behalf of the local EMO; and
- (c) co-ordinate all emergency services and other resources used in an emergency; or
- (d) ensure that someone is designated to discharge the responsibilities specified in paragraphs (a), (b) and (c).
- 10. The power to declare or renew a state of local emergency under the Act, the powers specified in Section 12 of this Bylaw, and the requirement specified in Section 15 of this Bylaw, are hereby delegated to a committee comprised of any three members of council. This committee may, at any time when it is satisfied that an emergency exists or may exist, by resolution, make a declaration of a state of local emergency.
- 11. When a state of local emergency is declared, the person or persons making the declaration shall:
 - ensure that the declaration identifies the nature of the emergency and area of the municipality in which it exists;
 - (b) cause the details of the declaration to be published immediately by such means of communication considered most likely to notify the population of the area affected;
 - (c) notify Saskatchewan Emergency Planning (SEP), as soon as is reasonably practicable; and
 - (d) forward a copy of the declaration to the Minister forthwith through SEP.
- 12. Subject to Section 15, when a state of local emergency is declared, the person or persons making the declaration may;
 - (a) cause the Municipal Emergency Plan or any related plans or programs to be put into operation;
 - (b) acquire or utilize any real or personal property considered necessary to prevent, combat or alleviate the effects of an emergency or disaster;
 - (c) authorize or require any qualified person to render aid of a type he or she is qualified to

provide;

- (d) control or prohibit travel to or from any area of the municipality;
- (e) provide for the restoration of essential facilities and the distribution of essential supplies and provide, maintain and co-ordinate emergency medical, welfare and other essential services in any part of the municipality;
- (f) cause the evacuation of person and the removal of livestock and personal property from any area of the municipality that is or may be affected by a disaster and make arrangements for the adequate care and protection of those persons or livestock and of personal property;
- (g) authorize the entry into any building or on any land, without warrant by any person in the course of implementing an emergency plan or program;
- (h) cause the demolition or removal of any trees, structure or crops if the demolition or removal is necessary or appropriate in order to reach the scene of a disaster, or to attempt to forestall its occurrence or to combat its progress;
- (i) procure to fix prices for food, clothing, fuel, equipment, medical supplies or other essential supplies and the use of any property, services, resources, or equipment with the municipality for the duration of the state of emergency;
- (j) authorize the conscription of persons needed to meet an emergency; and
- authorize any persons at any time, in the operation of the Municipal Emergency Plan and related plans or programs any power specified in Paragraph (b) through (k) in relation to any part of the municipality affected by a declaration of a state of local emergency.
- 13. When a state of local emergency is declared:
 - (a) neither Council nor any member of Council; and
 - (b) no person appointed by Council to carry our measures relating to emergencies or disasters; is liable to respect of damage caused through any action taken under this Bylaw, nor are they subject to any proceedings by prohibition, certiorari, mandamus or injunction.
- 14. Notwithstanding Section 13:
 - (a) Council and any member of Council, and
 - (b) any person acting under the direction or authorization of Council, is liable for gross negligence in carrying out their duties under this Bylaw.
- 15. When in the opinion of the person or persons declaring the state of local emergency, an emergency no longer exists in relation to which the declaration was made, they shall, by resolution terminate the declaration.
- 16. A declaration of the state of local emergency is considered terminated and ceases to be of any force or effect when:
 - (a) a resolution is passed under Section 15;
 - (b) a period of seven days lapsed since it was declared, unless it is renewed by resolution;
 - (c) the Lieutenant Governor on Council makes an order for a state of emergency under the Act, relating to the same area; or
 - (d) the Minister cancels the state of local emergency.

17. When a declaration of a state of local emergency has been terminated, the persons or persons who made the declaration shall cause the details of the termination to be published immediately by such means of communication considered most likely to notify the population of the area affected and shall notify Saskatchewan Emergency Planning as soon as is reasonably practicable.

BYLAW NO. 3-2008

Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES AND THE USE OF THE HIGHWAYS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. In this bylaw, including this section:
 - a) "all terrain vehicle" and/or "ATV" means all terrain vehicle as defined in *The All Terrain Vehicles Act:*
 - b) "highway" means a highway as defined in *The Highway Traffic Act* and includes a road, parkway, driveway, square or place designed and intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles, but does not include any area, whether privately or publicly owned, that is primarily intended to be used for the parking of vehicles and the necessary passageways on that area;
 - c) "private land" means land other than public land as defined in *The All Terrain Vehicles Act*;
 - d) "public land" means Crown land or any land vested in the municipality, as defined in *The Terrain Vehicles Act*:
 - e) "traveled portion" means that part of a highway designed for vehicle travel including the shoulder of the road;
 - f) "untravelled portion" means that part of a highway not designed for vehicle travel including the ditch and the center median, if any;
 - g) "vehicle" means a vehicle as defined in The Highway Traffic Act.
- 2. A person is authorized to operate an all terrain vehicle (may specify class of ATV) on the traveled portion of any highway within the municipality.
- 3. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalty imposed by section 32 of *The All Terrain Vehicles Act*.

Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151

Zoning Amended Bylaw

A Bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 2-2005, the Municipality's Zoning Bylaw. The Council of the Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts:

- (1) To amend Bylaw No. 2-2005 as follows:
 - (A) By adding the following definitions at the appropriate alphabetical location in Part II Definitions:
 - "**Dwelling**: a building or part of a building that may be used as a Residence as defined in this Bylaw.";
 - "Dwelling, Dormitory: a series of dwelling units contained together in a single storey, residential dwelling either as an agricultural, accessory use or for the temporary accommodation of employees who are constructing a major commercial or industrial development for which a Permit has been issued in conformity with this Bylaw."; and
 - "Mobile Home Park: a site under one ownership, which has been planned, divided into mobile home lots and improved for the placement of mobile homes for residential use on a lease or rental basis.":
 - (B) By adding "or Dormitory Dwelling" to the definition of "Residence" in Part II Definitions, following the words "single detached dwelling";
 - (C) By deleting the definition of "Farmstead" in Part II Definitions, and replacing it with the following: "Farmstead: a single site which includes the residence or dormitory dwelling of the farm operator and those buildings or facilities which are related to the farm operation, and may include cropland and pastures.";
 - (D) By adding "(including a dormitory dwelling)" following the word "farmstead" in Section 5.2(2)(a) of the Agricultural District;
 - (E) By adding "(c) Mobile Home Park" and "(d) a single detached dwelling which may be allowed at Council's discretion on the existing Parcel A, Plan No. 101177603 Extension 52 (NE 22-17-32-1) in the former hamlet of Bear Creek" as new Discretionary Uses in Section 5.2(2) of the Agricultural District;
 - (F) By adding the following as a new Section 3.14:

"3.14 Regulations for Mobile Home Parks

In addition to the development standards, which may be contained in the required Discretionary Use Permit for a Mobile Home Park, the following regulations shall apply to the review and approval of Mobile Home Park applications.

- (1) The applicant shall provide the Development Officer with drawings of the lots, private roads, sewer and water services and accessory buildings proposed in the Mobile Home Park that have been approved by an Architect or Engineer that is licensed to practice within the Province of Saskatchewan.
- (2) The following accessory buildings and uses shall be permitted:
 - (a) an administration office for the mobile home park;
 - (b) one dwelling unit for the owner or operator;
 - (c) recreational buildings and uses servicing only the park's residents;
 - (d) laundry facilities for the use of the residents; and
 - (e) other service and storage buildings accessory to the operation of the park.
- (3) In Mobile Home Parks, only 1 accessory building shall be permitted within each mobile home lot, such accessory building shall not exceed 30m2.

(4) Each lot within a mobile home park shall:

- (a) access an internal, private road and have a driveway with a minimum width of 4.5m
- (b) be clearly identified with permanent address.
- (c) have a minimum lot area of 375m2 with a minimum width of 9m

(d) requirements for a mobile home lot are:

- a minimum of 1.5m side yard from any adjacent mobile home lot;
- a minimum of 3m rear or side yard from the mobile home park boundary;
- a minimum of 3m front yard from any internal road; and
- a minimum of 15m from any mobile home lot or permanent park accessory structure located on the opposite side of an internal road.
- (5) Mobile home parks shall provide a minimum of 10% of the total area, in a suitable location for the recreational use and the enjoyment of the park residents.
- (G) By deleting Subsection 5.3.2(1)(c) and replacing it with the following: "(c) A residential site shall not be less than 0.8 hectares (2acres) or more than 16 hectares (40 acres) in size."

(H) By adding the following as a new Section 5.3.2(1)(f):

- "(f) At the request of the current owner of the site proposed to be subdivided as referred to in subsection (d) above, Council may use it's discretion to vary only the maximum site size requirement up to a new maximum of 32 ha. (80 ac.). In such cases, the minimum remaining size of the Quarter Section (as defined by this Bylaw) shall not be less than 32 ha (80 ac.). As well, the requested change must be either:
 - i) requested to include additional land required for water supply or waste disposal systems which exist on or are proposed for the site; or
 - ii) requested to include or facilitate any existing or proposed landscaping, buildings, structures or natural features on the proposed site; or
 - iii) must not unnecessarily reduce, or negatively affect the existing use, size, servicing of, or access to the balance of the quarter section (or equivalent as defined in this Bylaw); and
 - iv) must not negatively affect the existing use, servicing of, or access to any neighboring land."
- (2) That the Administrator do such other things necessary to effect the intent of this Bylaw;
- (3) That this Bylaw shall take effect on the date it is approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.

 - (D) By adding "(including a dormitory dwelling)" following the word "farmstead" in Section 5.2(2)(a) of the Agricultural District;
 - (E) By adding "(c) Mobile Home Park" and "(d) a single detached dwelling which may be allowed at Council's discretion on the existing Parcel A, Plan No. 101177603 Extension 52 (NE 22-17-32-1) in the former hamlet of Bear Creek" as new Discretionary Uses in Section 5.2(2) of the Agricultural District;
 - (F) By adding the following as a new Section 3.14:

"3.14 Regulations for Mobile Home Parks

In addition to the development standards, which may be contained in the required Discretionary Use Permit for a Mobile Home Park, the following regulations shall apply to the review and approval of Mobile Home Park applications.

- (1) The applicant shall provide the Development Officer with drawings of the lots, private roads, sewer and water services and accessory buildings proposed in the Mobile Home Park that have been approved by an Architect or Engineer that is licensed to practice within the Province of Saskatchewan.
- (2) The following accessory buildings and uses shall be permitted:
 - (a) an administration office for the mobile home park;
 - (b) one dwelling unit for the owner or operator:
 - (c) recreational buildings and uses servicing only the park's residents;
 - (d) laundry facilities for the use of the residents; and
 - (e) other service and storage buildings accessory to the operation of the park.
- (3) In Mobile Home Parks, only 1 accessory building shall be permitted within each mobile home lot, such accessory building shall not exceed 30m2.

(4) Each lot within a mobile home park shall:

- (a) access an internal, private road and have a driveway with a minimum width of 4.5m
- (b) be clearly identified with permanent address.
- (c) have a minimum lot area of 375m2 with a minimum width of 9m
- (d) requirements for a mobile home lot are:
 - a minimum of 1.5m side yard from any adjacent mobile home lot;
 - a minimum of 3m rear or side yard from the mobile home park boundary;
 - a minimum of 3m front yard from any internal road; and
 - a minimum of 15m from any mobile home lot or permanent park accessory structure located on the opposite side of an internal road.
- (5) Mobile home parks shall provide a minimum of 10% of the total area, in a suitable location for the recreational use and the enjoyment of the park residents.
- (G) By deleting Subsection 5.3.2(1)(c) and replacing it with the following: "(c) A residential site shall not be less than 0.8 hectares (2acres) or more than 16 hectares (40 acres) in size."
- (H) By adding the following as a new Section 5.3.2(1)(f):
 - "(f) At the request of the current owner of the site proposed to be subdivided as referred to in subsection (d) above, Council may use it's discretion to vary only the maximum site size requirement up to a new maximum of 32 ha. (80 ac.). In such cases, the minimum remaining size of the Quarter Section (as defined by this Bylaw) shall not be less than 32 ha (80 ac.). As well, the requested change must be either:
 - i) requested to include additional land required for water supply or waste disposal systems which exist on or are proposed for the site; or
 - ii) requested to include or facilitate any existing or proposed landscaping, buildings, structures or natural features on the proposed site; or
 - iii) must not unnecessarily reduce, or negatively affect the existing use, size, servicing of, or access to the balance of the quarter section (or equivalent as defined in this Bylaw); and
 - iv) must not negatively affect the existing use, servicing of, or access to any neighboring land."
- (2) That the Administrator do such other things necessary to effect the intent of this Bylaw;
- (3) That this Bylaw shall take effect on the date it is approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.
