  - All that portion of the northwest quarter of Section Two (2), in Township Sixteen (16), in Range Thirty (30), West of the Principal Meridian in the Province of Saskatchewan, which is bounded on the north by the full supply level of the Beaver Creek Storage Basin.
- 3. THE PARTIES agree that there shall be no liability arising from this agreement for the cost of operating or maintaining the park after five years from April 1, 1976.

# INDENTURE OF AGREEMENT

BETWEEN:

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROCANVILLE NO. 151 having its office in the Town of Rocanville, in the Province of Saskatchewan, the Rural Municipality of the First Part;

and

THE TOWN OF ROCANVILLE in the Province of Saskatchewan, the Town of the Second Part;

WHEREAS the parties hereto are desirous of co-operating to carry out jointly a service, namely the operation and maintenance of the Rocanville and District Four Seasons Swimming Pool, in which they have a common interest and which each of them could lawfully carry out alone within its own territorial limits;

AND WHEREAS by virtue of Section 241 of The Rural Municipality Act, 1972, and subsection 1 of Section 235 of The Urban Municipality Act, they have the power to enter into an agreement to do so;

WITNESSETH that in consideration of the covenants, promises, agreements and undertakings hereinafter contained, on the part of the parties hereto,

IT IS AGREED AND UNDERSTOOD, THAT:

- (1) The ownership of the Rocanville and District Four Seasons Swimming Pool shall be shared between the Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151 and the Town of Rocanville, with the Rural Municipality Fifteen (15) percent of ownership, and the Town Eighty-Five (85) percent of ownership.
- (2) The Rural Municipality shall bear Forty (40) percent of the cost of operating and maintaining the Four Seasons Swimming Pool and share Forty (40) percent of surplus revenue over and above the cost of operating the pool.
- (3) The Town shall bear Sixty (60) percent of the cost of operating and maintaining the Four Seasons Swimming Pool and share Sixty (60) percent of surplus revenue over and above the cost of operating the pool.
- (4) Other matters of policy relative to the operation and ownership of the pool shall be determined by resolution of each Council.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF and by virtue of a bylaw passed by the Council of The Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151 and a bylaw passed by the Council of The Town of Rocanville, the said parties have each caused its corporate seal to be affixed hereto attested by the signatures of its proper officers in that behalf.
