RESTRICTED DRILLING

17/07 Holland: WHEREAS the Oil and Conservation Act (1985) outlines the regulations and restrictions regarding which areas may, and may not be drilled for natural resources; and

WHEREAS private landowners in the Rural Municipality of Rocanville (RM 151) have previously been able to supplement their incomes by leasing the oil and seismic testing rights on their property; and

WHEREAS in 1996, without prior consultation, warning, or explanation, individuals owning land within the vicinity of the Potash Corporation of Saskatchewan (PCS) mine a Rocanville, Saskatchewan were suddenly prevented from leasing the oil and seismic testing rights on their respective properties as a result of a drilling restriction implemente by the province of Saskatchewan and the PCS; and

WHEREAS rural communities in Saskatchewan continue to face considerable economic hardships in light of low agricultural commodity prices and rising input costs; and

WHEREAS the income received through the leasing of seismic testing and oil rights constituted a substantial and predictable source of income for the RM of Rocanville as well as said landowners; and

WHEREAS for more than a decade, private landowners and the RM Rocanville have lost this source of income due to the drilling restriction; and WHEREAS oil companies have expressed considerable interest in exploring the potential for further development of Saskatchewan's oil and gas industry in the Rocanville area; and

WHEREAS the Government of Saskatchewan has publicly expressed its commitment to the development of the oil and gas industry in Saskatchewan; and WHEREAS the Government of Saskatchewan, and the Potash Corporation of Saskatchewan have yet to provide sound scientific evidence supporting the size of, and necessity for, a restricted drilling zone in the vicinity of the PCS mine at Rocanville, Saskatchewan; and

WHEREAS the RM of Rocanville, private landowners and concerned stakeholders recognize that safety precautions are necessary to protect the PCS of Rocanville and its workers.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that a full scientific study be immediately conducted which justifies the need for, and size of, the current restricted drilling zone, and be released to the RM of Rocanville, concerned stakeholders and private landowners upon its completion; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the RM of Rocanville urges the Government of Saskatchewan to fully implement the findings and recommendations of this review to ensure that the interests of the Potash Corporation of Saskatchewan, the RM of Rocanville, private landowners, and concerned stakeholders are realized to their fullest potential; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Government of Saskatchewan and the Potash Corporation of Saskatchewan provide adequate compensation for the loss of income endured by landowners in the RM of Rocanville since the implementation of the drilling restriction; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pending the release of a valid, evidence based review for the necessity, and size of, the present restricted drilling zone, the Minister of Industry and Resources consider immediately lifting said restrictions on a case by case basis as outlined in Section 20(3) of the *Oil and Conservation Act* (1985); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution be forwarded to the Provincial Minister of Industry and Resources, the Provincial Minister of Agriculture, the Member of the Legislative Assembly for Moosomin, and the CEO of the Potash Corporation of Saskatchewan.

Carried.

SARM - RESTRICTED DRILLING RESOLUTION

Parks: That the Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151 submits the following resolution to SARM for presentation at the SARM 2007 Annual Convention; WHEREAS the *Oil and Conservation Act* (1985) outlines the regulations and restrictions regarding which areas may, and may not be drilled for natural resources; and

WHEREAS in 1996, without prior consultation, warning, or explanation, individuals owning land within the restricted area around potash mines in Saskatchewan were suddenly prevented from leasing the oil and seismic testing rights on their respective properties as a result of a drilling restriction implemented by the province of Saskatchewan; and

WHEREAS private landowners in the rural municipalities who have previous to 1996 been able to supplement their incomes by leasing the oil and seismic testing rights on their property have lost this source of income due to the drilling restrictions and have now for more than a decade lost substantial revenue due to the drilling restrictions.

THERE BE IT RESOLVED that the Government of Saskatchewan and the Potash Mines provide adequate compensation for the loss of income resulting from the implementation of the drilling restriction implemented in 1996, to the landowners whose drilling rights have been denied.
