

Township Road 163 (Powerline Rd)

This project was awarded to D.J. Miller & Sons and was started in the fall of 2023. This project is a total of 5 miles from the 601 East to Prosperity Road (Range Road 1324).

Range Road 1304 (Mine Hill Rd)

The RM has awarded the Clay Capping of Range Road 1304 from SW 28-17-30 to Township Road 172 to Springer Construction. This project is about 2.5 miles in length and is slotted to be completed by the end of July.

719 Grid

The RM has awarded this 5 mile clay capping project to C.K. Construction and is slotted to be completed by the beginning of October. This 5 mile of road construction will take place from the 601 to Prosperity Road (Range Road 1324).

Taxation

There will be no changes to tax rates as set by council for the 2024 year. They will remain the same as last year which is as follows:

- ♦ Mill Rate (MR) 11.0 Mills
- ♦ MRF (Ag 0.82, Res 0.6, Comm 0.9) (Therefore the Effective Mill Rate will be MR x MRF)
- ♦ Min Tax—\$50 per parcel

Controlled Burns 1-866-404-4911

ALWAYS Report your planned controlled Burn! This will avoid fire trucks responding. If your burn is not reported, you will be invoiced for the cost of the Fire Department.

Water

Please be advised that the well water located on NW33-16-32 W1 is not treated or tested and is considered unpotable. DO NOT USE this water for drinking, cooking, food preparation, or hygiene purposes.

The Water from the RM yard in town is potable. Please see Administration to purchase a key fob for \$20.

Organic Farms

Please let the RM Office know if you farm organically and we can add this land to our Map and inform spraying companies upon their request.

Ratepayer Gravel & Sand

Ratepayers are entitled to 5 loads of gravel per farmyard per year at cost plus trucking. (For 2024: \$12/yard + \$0.5/yd/mi hauling for crushed gravel, \$5/yard + \$0.5/yd/mi hauling for pit run.) Gravel delivery occurs usually on the first Monday and Tuesday of each month.

This year the RM also has sand available for ratepayers. The cost to ratepayers is \$10/yard + \$0.5/yd/mi hauling.

Annual cut off and delivery may be dependent on weather.

Ratepayer Dust Control

FOR 2024: The RM charges ratepayers \$350 per 200m application of MG30 Dust Control. Dust Control orders need to be received by May of each year.

Road Allowance

The RM has a 99-foot Road Allowance on all roads. There shall be NO equipment, fences, farming, spraying, digging or items put on the right of way. Council may fine ratepayers found to be impairing the Right of Way via the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality. This Penalty is up to \$2,000 for Individuals and \$5,000 for Corporations. Council also has the right to Mow the Right of Way.

Drainage

Ratepayers must apply for approval to construct & operate drainage works under the Water Security Agency (WSC) or phone the Yorkton Office @ 1-306-786-1490.

What Does The RM Offer Me?

The RM offers many services to our ratepayers. This includes snow plowing of lanes at no charge (which is charged in other RM's) and discounted rates on gravel and dust control. There is also the free use of our transfer station and water wells. We also support recreation, town facilities and local community organizations.

Mulching/Weed Spraying

The RM had contracted Maverick Construction for Mulching, and Green Acres Consulting for Weed Spraying. If you have any areas of concern for either mulching or noxious weeds—Please contact your division Councillor.

Mowing

Silver Dirtworks Ltd. is scheduled to mow the RM in September/October of this year.

Cemeteries

The RM can accept donations to the Cemeteries in our RM and issue you a tax receipt for the donation.
