Rocanville R. M. No. 151

Annual Meeting, Oct. 23, 1961.

The Annual Ratepayers' meeting of Rocanville R.M. 151 was held on Monday, Oct. 23, 1961, in the Memorial Hall with 39 in attendance.

D.W. Strong nominated Leslie McGutcheon to be chairman of the meeting. On motion of W.D. Tebb and C.W. ~~Salonen~~ Salonen nominations were closed. Mr. McGutcheon took the chair. The agenda for the meeting was read and

adapted on motion of J. Rushton and C. Windrim.

The minutes were read and adapted on motion of E. Thompson.

The Nine months' financial statement was read and discussed.

It was moved by H.C. Watson and seconded by J.W. Bearance that the Financial statement be adapted as read. carried.

The Tax collection report was given by the Secretary and adapted on motion of D.W. Strong and R.B. McClelland.

There was considerable discussion on the question of a ~~##~~ Closed Herd Law in the Municipality.

It was moved by Fred Karras and seconded by D. Strong that we have a year-round closed herd Law.

H.C. Watson and E. Horodychuk moved an amendment to the effect that we abide by the decisions of the Council ~~####~~ regarding a closed Herd Law.

Upon being put to a vote the amendment was declared lost. The original motion in favour of a year-round closed Herd Law carried on a vote of 17 in favour, and 11 against.

At 4.00 P.M. (Local time) nominations for Councillors were declared closed and results announced:

Div. 2 Lorne Goodman nominated;

Div. 4 H.W. Hooper nominated;

Div. 6 A.M. Peterson... nominated.

As there were no other nominations the three nominees were declared elected as Councillors for the ensuing ~~####~~ two years/.

A report on Grid Road construction was given showing that to date 26 miles of Grid Road has been constructed with 21 miles yet to be built. This report was received on motion of C.L. Windrim and E. Dunsmore.

It was also reported that 32 carloads of hay had been shipped in by rail and distributed among farmers.

It was moved by H.C. Watson and seconded by K. Christie that the Council try to obtain price quotations on shipments of oats and take orders for oats required by farmers in the R.M. Motion carried.

The Reeve and the Councillors present reported briefly on the work of the year. Councillor Goodman pointed out that the taxes on the Oil wells amounted to about \$1100 per annum. Retiring Councillor Salonen stated that his term in office gave him an opportunity to become better acquainted with the people and with the problems of the area. He thanked the ratepayers for support given him and hoped they would give full support to his successor, Mr. Peterson.

There was some discussion on the question of having a definite standard # for road construction, and on the problem of second growth on road allowances where the brush had been cleared.

H.C. Watson moved a vote of thanks to the Council for the good work done during the year.

The meeting adjourned on motion of W.E. Duce.
