- That Parties expressly covenant and agree that the Requesting Party shall, in respect of third 13. party claims of any nature arising from the provision of Fire Services by the Providing Party under this agreement, indemnify and hold harmless and keep indemnified and held harmless the Assisting Party from and against all loss, costs, claims, expenses, demands, claims, actions and causes of action asserted by the third parties and in any way arising from performance or non-performance under this Agreement by the Assisting Party. The within covenants of indemnity shall survive the termination of this Agreement with respect to any cause of action arising during the currency hereof.
