Province Council of the Rural Municipality of of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows;-Rocanville No. 151, in the

- The council may by resolution appoint a committee, comprising of two of its members, with authority on behalf of the municipality, subjecto Section 3, hereof, to issue orders in accordance with regulations prescibed by the Minister of Rural Development: council may by subject
- prohibiting the operation of tractors on any road or roads in the municipality designated by such order;
- (b) SB restricting the operation of vehicles, other than tractors, a gross weight in excess of 2,700 kilograms or such greater committee may designate; having weight
- (c) restricting the gross weight that through any point or points of ctractors operating on specified the gross weight of the vehicle exceeds that my be transmitted to the road contact roads in . of of any vehicle, other then the municipality where 2,700 kilograms; other than
