Herd Law. was then discussed
and. Moved by C. McCutcheon sec
by Comm. McKee that Herd Law
be enacted ~~to~~ ^{as} follows.

1. That no Bull Stallion or Boar
be allowed to run at large at
any time.
2. That no Cattle, bear, horse
sheep or swine shall be
allowed to run at large ~~between~~
the fifteenth day of May next-
following to the 15 day of November
both dates inclusive.
- ~~3. That the rates chargeable by~~
~~any person~~
3. That any Bull Stallion or Boar
found running at large at any
time may be impounded ~~by~~
any person find the same at-
large in ~~the~~ legal found
in the District and shall be
entitled to remuneration for
such service in the sum of
Five Dollars.
4. That any Cattle, bear, horse
sheep or swine found at large

Rates for
impounding

within the Limits of L.D. 15-1
May be impounded in any
legal pound within the district
and the fee chargeable for
impounding said stock shall
be

Remuneration for time in impounding
and any damage done by the
said stock while at large.

5. That the fees collectable by
each poundkeeper for remuneration
for his services as poundkeeper
shall be.

(1) 50 cents per diem or part thereof
for each bull stallion or boar

(2) 15 cents per diem for each cattle
beast or horse

(3) 10 cents per diem for each
sheep or swine.

and the said poundkeeper shall
in consideration of said rates
provide necessary food and water
for said stock while in his
possession.

In addition to above he
shall be entitled to 10 cts
per notice for each notice posted
up. 10 cts for each copy to
Gazette. and 10 cts for each notice
to News papers.

and necessary Newspaper adt. not
to exceed 2⁰⁰ for each notice.
for three insertion.
