- 2. Every order issued under the provisions of Section 1 shall be issued in accordance with the regulations prescribed by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.
- 3. The provisions of section 1 shall not apply to any Provincial. highway.
- 4. No person shall deface, injure, knock down, or remove any notice posted by, or by authority of a committee appointed under section 1 hereof.
- 5. Any person found guilty of an infraction of an order of any such Committee, or any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.
