The/Ratepayers meeting of Rocanville R.M. No. 151 was held in the Community Hall on Monday, Oct. 24, 1949, with 49 Ratepayers present.

On motion of C.C. Hutchinson & D.N. Sutton, MR. A.J. Calder, the present Reeve, was elected as Chairman of the meeting.

On motion of J.F. Rushton & A.I. Johnston, the minutes of last meeting were adapted as read.

The Interim Financial Statement for the First 9 months of 1949 was given by the Secretary, and adapted on motion of A.G. Kelly & J. Heap.

On motion of J. Heap & E. Dunsmore, the Secretary's report of Tax Collections was received.

At 2.00 P.M. (M.S.T.), the Returning Officer declared the meeting open for nominations for Reeve and for Councillors for Div. 2, 4, & 6.

At 3.00 P.M. (M.S.T.), nominations were closed.

On the basis of nominations received, the Returning Officer declared Mr. A.J. Calder re-elected for Reeve for the ensuing ONE year, and the following Councillors re-elected for the ensuing TWO years:

Div. 2 G.E. Thompson;

Div. 4 D.N. Sutton;

Div. 6 B. Wilson.

The report of the Agricultural Committee was given by the Chairman, Mr. C.F. Chase. He explained that the plans for a Field Day had to be postponed. He outlined the Atlacide project with the Govt. Spraying machine, and intimated that the campaign against Leafy Spurge was to be continued, and urged all farmers to report patches of Leafy Spurge. On motion of L. Gagnon & Geo. Williamson, this report was received.

A constructive discussion followed re road-building and purchase of road equipment. A number of suggestions were made for consideration by the Council.

The problem of Coyote Control was also discussed and suggestions made.

It was also recommended that the closed season for Weasels be continued.

The meeting was addressed briefly by the Reeve and Councillors of the various Divisions.

Reeve Calder reported that he and the Council had worked together in harmony, that they had done their best in the interests of the Municipality and would continue to do so.

Councillor Gagnon expressed his appreciation for the cooperation received. Councillor Thompson urged a re-allocation of Road grant funds, and explained that he planned to continue the roadwork on the road West from Rocanville.

Dep-Reeve Hutchinson reported that he had managed to do a lot of satisfactory roadwork, and thanked those who had ~~#####~~ contributed in this work. Councillor Sutton expressed his appreciation for the cooperation received from a goodly number of Ratepayers. He felt that light graders would be more satisfactory for road-maintaining than are the Flat grags now in use. He requested that all farmers desiring to have brushing cutting done this winter to report the number of acres at an early date to the Secretary or a member of the Council.

Councillor Kaplun reported that he had received splendid cooperation in work and contributions, and he was able to grade or repair many stretches of road during the season. Councillor Wilson reported having graded up to standard 3 miles of road and was at the present time, undertaking to gravel 2 miles.

On motion of L. McCutcheon, a hearty vote of thanks was extended to the Reeve and Council for their efforts.

The meeting adjourned at 5.15, on motion of C.J. Dunsmore.

A bylaw to authorize the appointment of a committee to restrict the weight of vehicles using the Municipal roads at certain times.

The council of the Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 161 enacts as follows:

1. The council is hereby authorized to appoint by resolution at any time a committee consisting of the Reeve and one Councillor, which may by order prohibit the operation of Tractors, and restrict to a maximum of six thousand pounds the weight of other vehicles with their loads using any road or roads within the Municipality.
2. Every order issued under the provisions of Section 1 shall be issued in accordance with the regulations proscribed by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.
3. The provisions of section 1 shall not apply to any Provincial highway.
4. No person shall deface, injure, knock down, or remove any notice posted by, or by authority of a committee appointed under section 1 hereof.
5. Any person found guilty of an infraction of an order of any such Committee, or any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.

Read three times by unanimous vote, and passed by the Council of the Rural Municipality of ROCANVILLE No. 161, in the Province of Saskatchewan, this 2nd day of March, A.D. 1949.
