



With no ratepayers in attendance, the Annual Meeting of ratepayers was not held.


At 3.00 P. M. (CST) nominations for Councilors were declared closed by the Returning Officer.


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
A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR
