ANNUAL MEETING, 1950 Oct. 23/50.

The Annual meeting of the Ratepayers of Rocanville R.M. No. 151 was held in the Memorial Hall with 49 ratepayers in attendance. Mr. A.J. Calder, present Reeve was nominated as chairman of the meeting by C.C. Hutchinson, and on motion of B. Kaplun and G.E. Thompson he was elected to preside for the meeting.

The minutes of last annual meeting were adapted on motion of H. Bell and J.W. Kydd.

The Interim Financial statement was given by the Secretary and was received on the motion of C.C. Hutchinson and A.G. Kelly. At 2.00 P.M. (M.S.T.) the Returning Officer declared the meeting open for nominations for Reeve, and for Councillors for Div. 1, 3, and 5.

At 3.00 P.M. (M.S.T.), nominations were declared closed.

On the basis of nominations received, the Returning Officer declared Mr. A.J. Calder re-elected as Reeve for the ensuing one year, Mr. C.C. Hutchinson re-elected as Councillor for Div. 3 for the ensuing 2 years; and Mr. B. Kaplun re-elected as Councillor for Div. 5, for the ensuing 2 years.

In Div. 1, Mr. L. Gagnon and Mr. A.R. Reid were nominated to contest the seat on the Council, election day being Nov. 1.

There was considerable discussion re roads in one area of the Municipality.

The Reeve and the Councillors in attendance briefly addressed the meeting.

Reeve Calder thanking the ratepayers for the confidence expressed, assured them that he would continue to give of his best during the coming year.

Deputy Reeve Hutchinson and Councillor Kaplun reported that the goodly number of voluntary contributions had assisted greatly in getting an extra amount of roadwork done. Councillor Gagnon reported on the success he had in helping to re-sell land which had been acquired through Tax enforcement proceedings. He also mentioned the difficulty of filling the many pot-holes in the roads which had developed during recent wet years. Councillor Thompson reported gravelling part of the road West of town, but explained that he had insufficient funds to complete the grading and gravelling this year. He called for a re-allocation of the divisional appropriations for the future. Councillor Sutton reported that he was able to grade 5 miles of road and gravel 3 miles of road, thanks, in part, to voluntary assistance.

Mr. A.R. Reid, the new nominee for Div. 1 spoke briefly, indicating his readiness to do his best, if elected as Councillor.

On motion of B. Kaplun and Geo. Reid, it was recommended that the Council give consideration to the matter of closed herd-law, all year.

The Municipal Inspector's report was read and received on motion of H.C. Watson and A.R. Reid.

Mr. H.C. Watson urged that consideration be given, at an early date, to a new method of apportioning the funds for roadwork in the various divisions and outlined two alternative methods.

Mr. W. Crawford asked that a different type of road be tried in place of the narrow road with deep ditches that was being constructed in some places.

On motion of H.C. Watson a hearty vote of thanks was extended to the Reeve and Councillors for their efforts during the year.

The meeting adjourned at 5.30, on motion of C.C. Hutchinson.
