Annual Meeting, Rocanville R.M. No. 151

The annual meeting of Rocanville R.M. No. 151 was held on Monday, Oct. 27, 1958, with an attendance of 52.

On motion of I. Polvi and Wm Heincke, Mr. A. Cláder (Reeve) was elected as chairman for the meeting.

The chairman read the proposed agenda for the meeting, and this was adapted on motion of A.G. Kelly and E. Horodychuk.

The minutes of the last annual meeting were read and adapted on motion of A.G. Kelly & Geo. Williamson.

A report was given re the new Whitewood Hospital and the Moosomin Union Hospital.

A report was given re the new re-assessment of the Municipality and an outline of the procedure re any appeals of assessment.

The report of the Agricultural Committee was given by A. Hugh Kelly. He pointed out that the T&B testing revealed only 2 reactors. Re referred to the re-organization of the 4H club, with Mr. L. Wotherspoon as leader. He also mentioned that a start had been made with the calfhood vaccination program and more was expected to be done in future.

At 3.00 P.M., Local Time, the Returning Officer called for nominations for Reeve and for Councillors for Div. 1, 3, & 5.

Nominations closed at 4.00 P.M., Local time. On the basis of the nominations received, the Returning Officer announced the following:

Reeve Calder re-elected by acclamation for 2 years.

In Div. 3. Leslie McCutcheon was elected as Councillor for 2 years, by acclamation. It was also announced that there would be two Polls:

In Div. 1, with L. Gagnon and E.C. Langley nominated.

In Div. 5, with B. Kaplun and H.A. Pakkala nominated.

The Financial statment for the 9 months of 1958 was read and received on motion of H.R. Bell and A.G. Kelly.

There was considerable discussion re finances and road construction problems. A suggestion was made calling for a study group to outline an over-all plan of road construction. Grid Road construction and kindred problems were also discussed.

A lengthy discussion was held re the matter of the Municipality's road equipment. It was hoped that some guidance might be given the Councillor in arriving at a decision re such questions as the following:

1. Should we sell our TD 18 equipment, buy another motor grader and hire a contractor to to the filling and grader work on roads?
2. Should we keep the TD 18 equipment and operate same?
3. Should we buy a new caterpillar (Crawler) tractor?

These were considered very important questions to be decided.

The Reeve and the Councillors present gave a brief report of the year's operations. As the Councillor for Div. 6 was unable to be present the Reeve reported briefly for him.

Mr. F. Surridge moved a vote of appreciation to the Council and Secretary for their efforts, which was apluded.

J.W. Kydd, reiring Councillor voiced his thanks for the cooperation he had received during his term on the Council.

Leslie McCutcheon, newly-elected Councillor for Div. 3, offered his thanks for the cooperation he hoped to receive.

The nominees for Councillor for Div. 1 and Div. 5, who were presnt, spoke briefly, and solicited support at the polls.

The question of Mountain Standard time and Central Standard time was considered. The motion of Hugh Kelly and H. Hooper that in this area Central Standard time was preferable carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 5.00 P.M. on motion of A.H. Kelly.

A bylaw relating to loans for seed grain and other supplies,
The Council of The Rural Municipality of ROCANVILLE NO. 151 of SASKATCHEWAN,
enacts as follows:

1. This Municipality for the year 1958 advance seed grain, petroleum products, feed grain and fodder, owing to crop failure or other adverse conditions, are unable to procure the same, and the council may, to enable it to make such advances, borrow upon the promissory note or notes of the Municipality the sum of FIFTEEN HUNDRED (\$1500.00) Dollars, for the purpose of obtaining a supply thereof for distribution.

2. The purchase price of all seed grain and other supplies advanced hereunder shall be secured by promissory notes due on demand and by registered liens in favour of the Municipality upon all crops grown on the lands named in the agreements for liens in respect of the advances and by the registration of caveats against the lands in respect of which the advances are made.

3. The maximum amount of advances under this by-law to any one farmer be ONE HUNDRED and FIFTY (\$150.00) Dollars.
