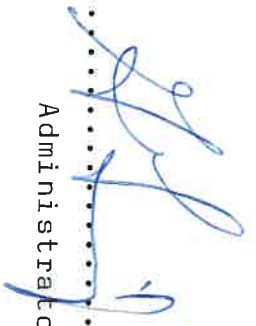

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROCANVILLE NO. 151
FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING A CAPITAL TRUST FUND.

WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151 deems it desirable to repeal the existing Capital Trust Bylaw as may have been increased and to create a new Capital Trust Fund for the constructing or acquiring of capital works, including the purchase of machinery, and such other purposes as may be approved by the Local Government Board pursuant to Section 266 of The Rural Municipality Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151 hereby enacts:-

1. THAT, for the purpose hereinbefore stated and subject to the approval of the Local Government Board, a Capital Trust Fund in the sum of One Hundred and Thirty Four Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$134,500.00) shall be created.

2. THERE shall be assigned to the said fund the following:

(a) The total amount for which the Capital Trust Fund under Bylaw No. 2-82 was created represented by all cash in the fund, plus outstanding repayments of withdrawals from the Fund as authorized by the Local Government Board, plus all outstanding instalments due for fund increases

\$ 93,000.00

(b) Current Year Cash Contribution

\$ 41,500.00

Total of Capital Trust Fund

\$ 134,500.00

and same shall be deposited with a chartered bank or credit union incorporated under the Credit Union Act and held in a separate and designated account called "The Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151 Capital Trust Fund."

3. THE establishment, addition to, reduction of, and use of the Fund shall be subject to the approval of the Local Government Board upon such terms and conditions as the Board may specify.

4. CAPITAL Trust Fund Bylaw No. 2-82 is hereby repealed.

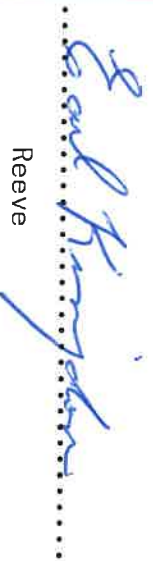

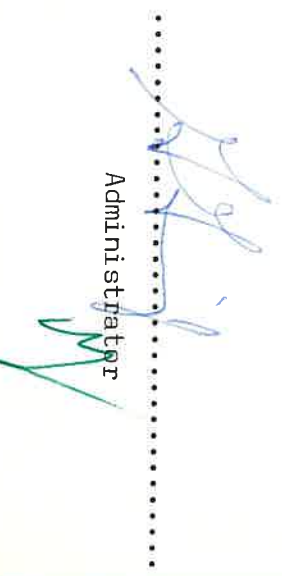

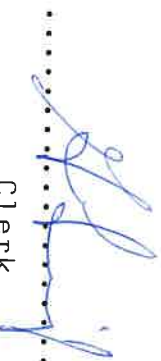

A BYLAW CONCERNING THE ERECTION OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SIGNS:

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Rocanville No. 151 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows;

1. In this Bylaw the expression "road" means any public highway within the municipality as defined in The Highways and Transportation Act, 1983-84, other than a Provincial Highway as designated pursuant to such Act.

2. Yield signs shall be erected at the intersection of roadways at the following locations:

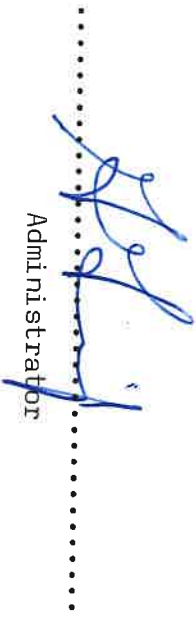
3. All signs erected pursuant to Section 2 hereto shall be erected not less than three metres and not more than fifteen metres from the near edge of the intersected roadway.
4. The provisions of The Vehicles Act shall apply, wherever applicable, to every sign erected pursuant to Section 2.
5. No person shall alter, damage, remove, deface, knock down or tamper with any sign erected pursuant to this Bylaw.
6. Any person who violates any provision of this Bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.

7. Erection of highway traffic sign Bylaw No. 3-78 passed July 11th., 1978 and the amending Bylaw No. 1-82 passed April 6th., 1982 are hereby repealed.
