

1) reimburse the Town on demand, Sixty-Five (65) percent of the cost of the total operations of the Rocanville Volunteer Fire Department.

THE TOWN OF ROCANVILLE, of the Second Part, will;

- make space available in the fire hall owned by and situated in the Town, to house the equipment such as portable pump and tank, suction hoses and valves, owned by the jointly owned emergency vehicle, pumper truck, equipment and appurtenances such as; ladders, hoses, nozzles, couplings, hats, coats, boots, etc., along with the additional municipality.
- 7 have qualified members inspect and test the trucks and equipment periodically
- ယ ensure as far as possible that they will be in a state of readiness at all times instruct the Fire Chief and his Deputies to supply an agreed upon number of duly qualified members of the Fire Department to man the trucks on call and proceed with all possible speed to any fire or fires in the Rural Municipality of Rocanville or the Town of fighting the fire Rocanville and where to operate the equipment, and in every way possible assist in




